There were six of us in the van. We talked along the way. A number of people were served, all ages and races. What I remember most were the women in general. I wondered why and what happened in their lives to end up living on the streets. There was one young woman alone in the streets sitting on the sidewalk. I thought, "Where do they sleep at night? We ministered to one woman whose face I can't erase from my mind. Her story was heartbreaking. She suffered with low self-esteem. The team prayed with her and tried to comfort her but the more we talked and prayed the more she cried. Eventually she was in agreement that she was smart and beautiful and that God had given her a new family. God had a plan that day. He used us to reach this beautiful soul who had never opened up to anyone before. During the ride back everyone was silent. I believed we were all reflecting on the people we encouraged that day.


